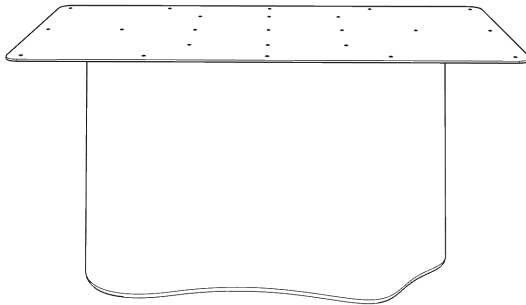

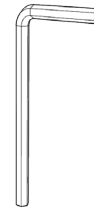

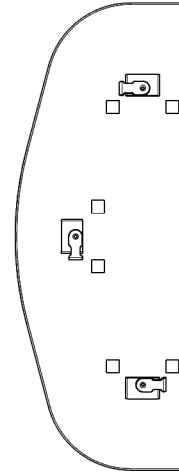
20x110cm:

End piece:

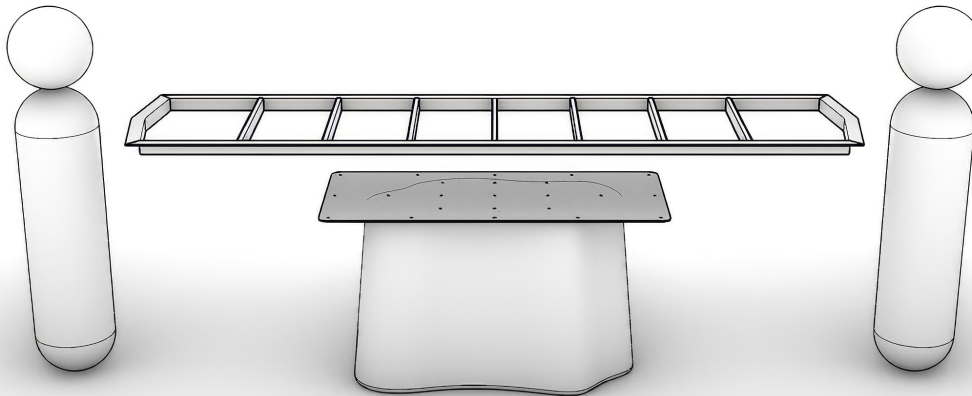

STEP 1

Unpack the two cardboard boxes containing the leg and the top metal frame.

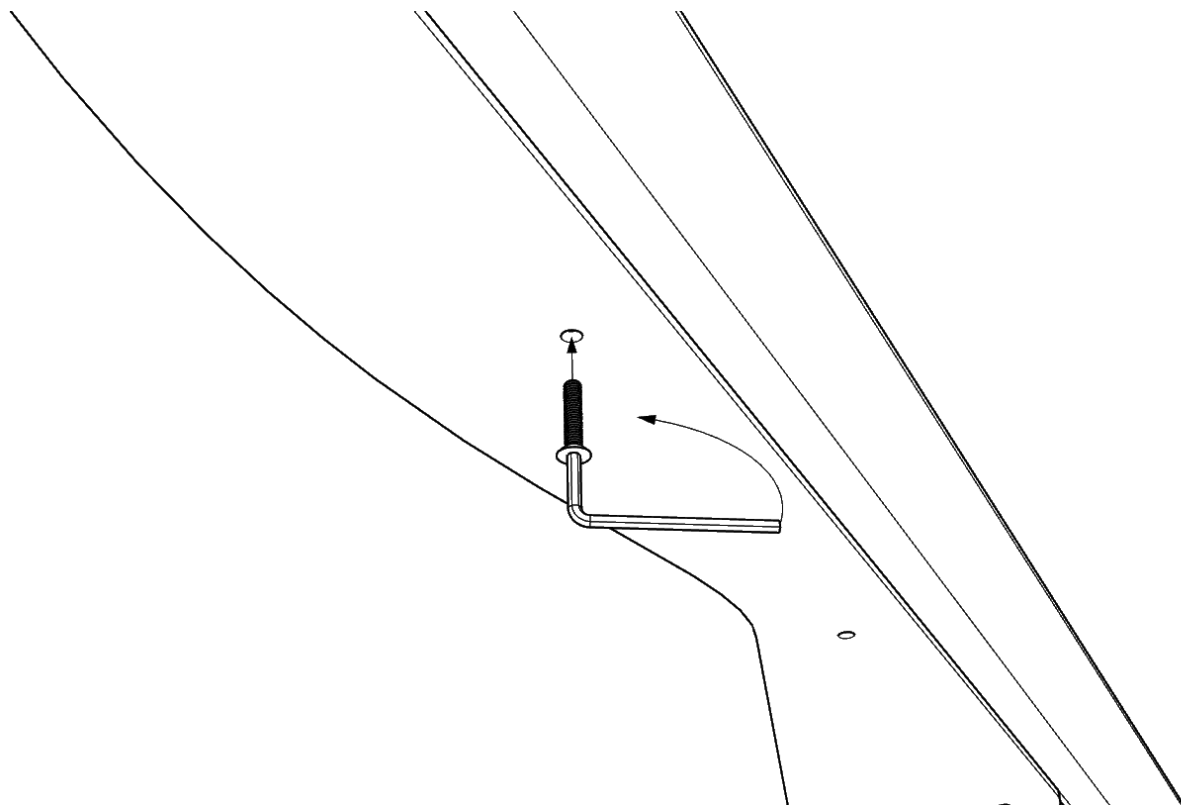
STEP 2

Align the top metal frame with the metal mounting plate.



STEP 3

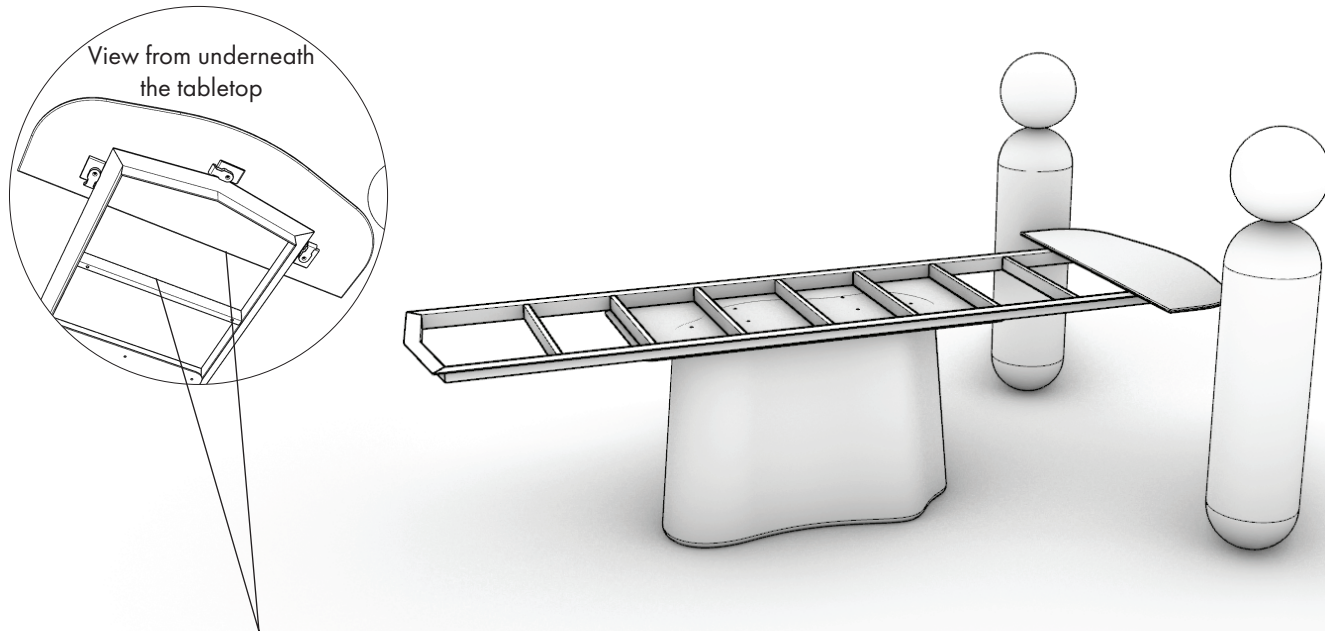
Using the provided screws and hex key,
securely fasten the leg to the top metal frame.



STEP 4

With the main table structure now assembled, carefully lift one of the glass/ceramic end panels with two people. Each person should hold one end of the panel to ensure safe handling.

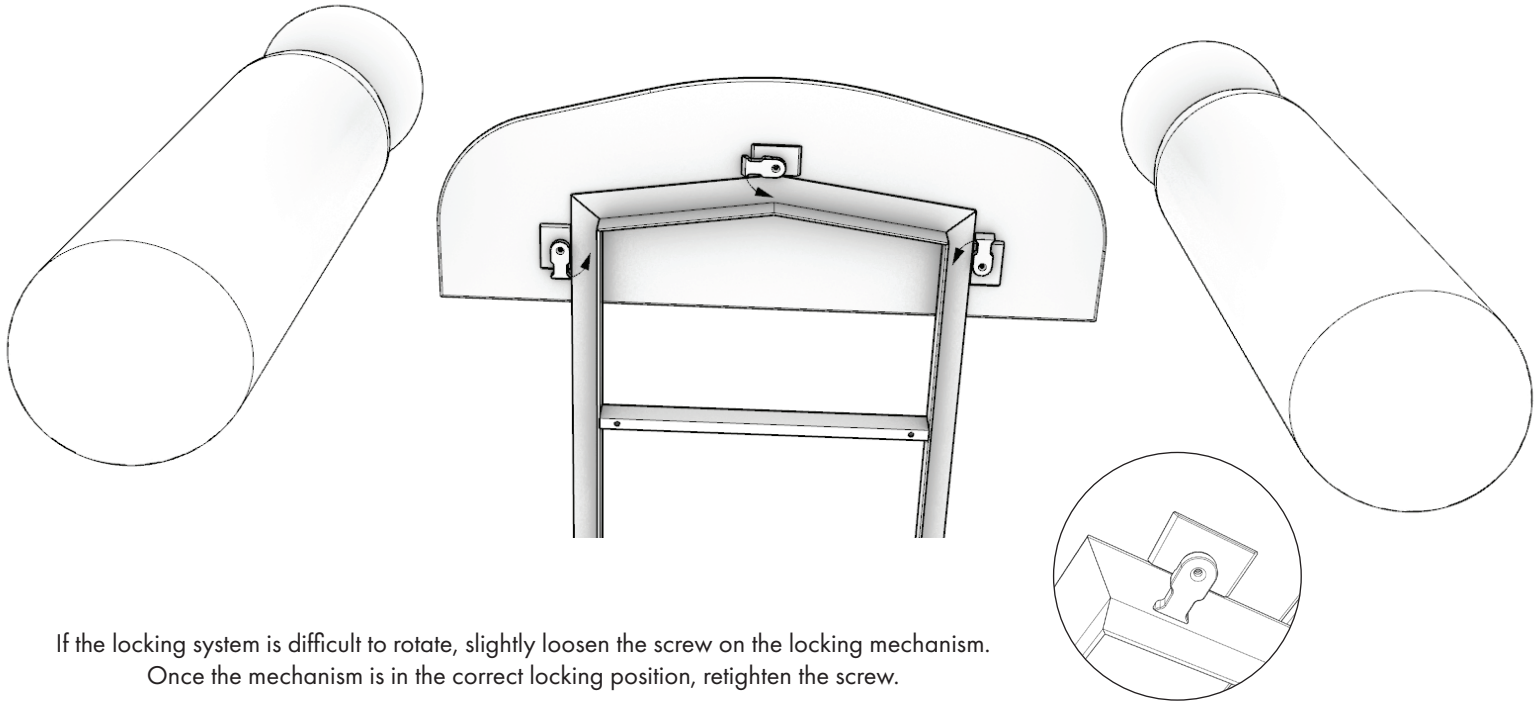
Place the panel onto the metal frame, making sure the frame sits correctly between the three plastic locking supports located underneath the glass.



* Make sure the edge of the glass is parallel to the metal frame to ensure correct installation.

STEP 5

Once the glass is properly aligned with the metal frame, rotate the locking system toward the frame to secure the glass top firmly in place.



If the locking system is difficult to rotate, slightly loosen the screw on the locking mechanism.
Once the mechanism is in the correct locking position, retighten the screw.

**! Do not force the locking system if you feel excessive resistance,
as this may damage the mechanism or the glass top !**

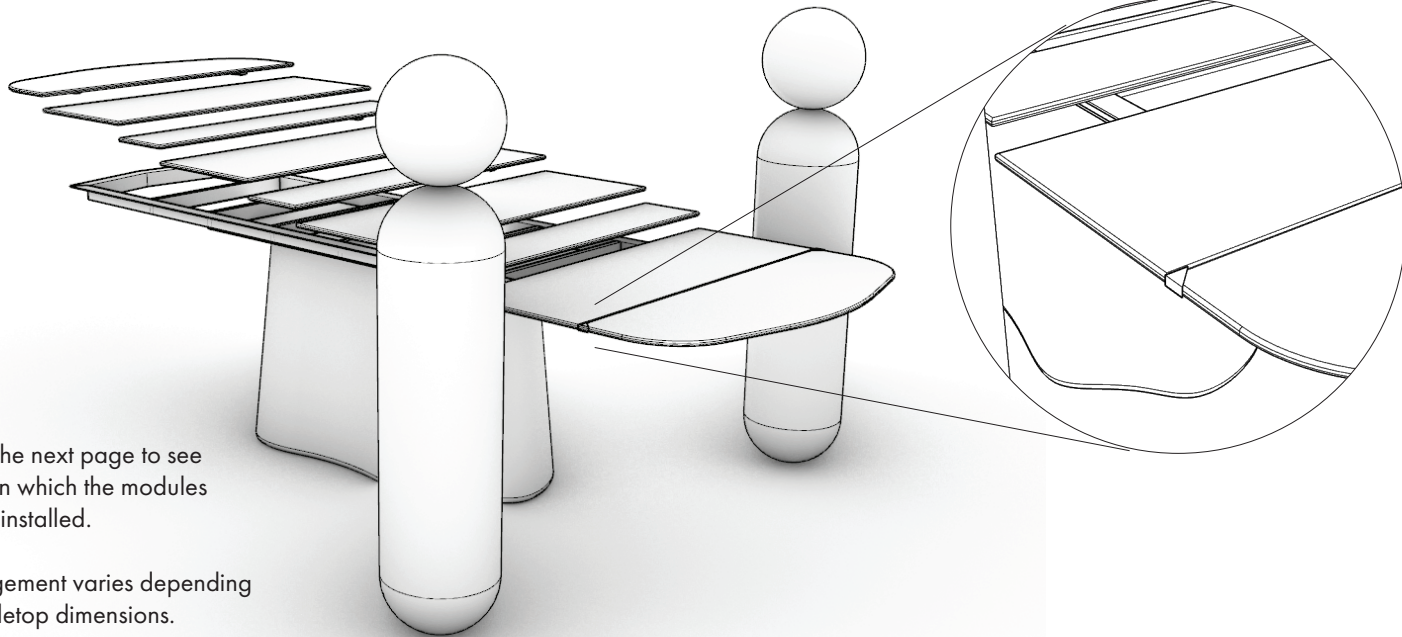
Locked position

STEP 6

Place the corner spacers on the edges of the secured glass panels.

Carefully position the next glass/ceramic top module against the spacers, making sure it sits snugly and is correctly aligned. Rotate the locking system to secure the new glass/ceramic module to the frame. Once the module is securely fixed, remove the spacers and place them on the outer corners of the newly installed module.

Repeat this process until all glass/ceramic top modules are securely fixed to the metal frame.



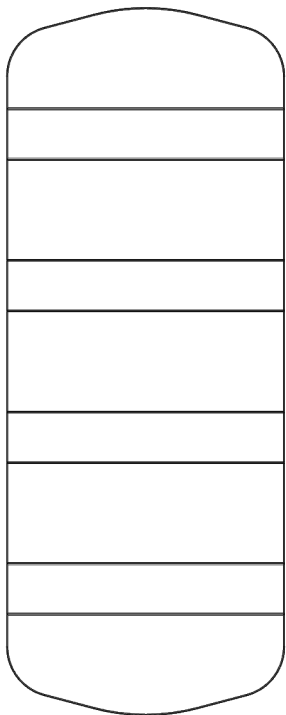

The arrangement varies depending on the tabletop dimensions.

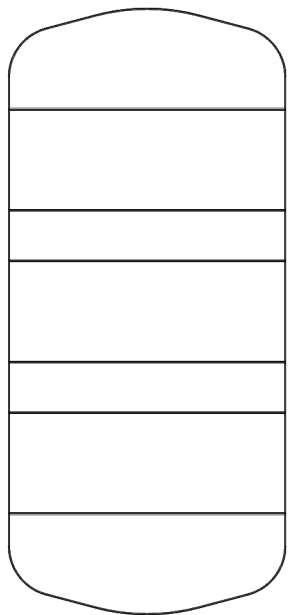

! DO NOT MOVE OR LIFT THE TABLE BY THE GLASS/CERAMIC TOP !

To move the table safely, first remove the glass/ceramic top modules from the metal frame.

Lift and move the table by holding the metal frame only.
Place the table in the desired location, then reinstall the glass/ceramic top modules.

After reinstalling the tabletop, make sure all screws on the locking systems are securely tightened to prevent any movement of the glass/ceramic modules.

Maintenance

Care and Maintenance of Your Glass/Ceramic Table:

Your table is designed with a glass/ceramic tabletop and a durable metal frame. To maintain its appearance and ensure long-lasting use, please follow the care and maintenance guidelines below.

Staining Risk:

Although the glass/ceramic tabletop is designed for everyday use, it should be handled with care.

Avoid dropping heavy or sharp objects onto the surface, particularly near the edges and corners, as impacts may cause chips, cracks, or other damage.

Do not sit, stand, or place excessive weight on the tabletop.

Cleaning Instructions:

Clean the tabletop using a soft cloth, water, and a mild cleaning product suitable for glass or ceramic surfaces.

Do not use abrasive sponges, scouring pads, or aggressive cleaning products, as these may damage or scratch the surface.

Hot Objects and Tableware:

We recommend using coasters, placemats, or trivets underneath hot cookware, drinks, and decorative objects

To protect the tabletop and minimise the risk of scratches or thermal damage. Avoid dragging heavy, rough, or sharp objects across the surface.

Warranty Void:

Failure to follow these guidelines will void the warranty on the table.
